

## RFP Summer Youth Q&A

Q: Are there defined percentages for serving “in school youth” vs “out of school youth”?

A: No

Q: How many youth would you like to be served under this program?

A: 30-50

Q: Will the awarded party be given access/trained on the E.F.M. system?

A: Yes to both

Q: It states this contract will run June 1st- October 31st, 2012. What type of program is this considered, as it is typically run year around, does this have a more career orientation? Could you expand on how we can obtain educational/GED/certification in a short timeframe for participants?

A: This is a short term Summer program focused on preparing at-risk youth to find employment, return to school, or enter secondary school training. Certification should be industry recognized, but what they include is the responsibility of the proposer.

Q: Page #11 section E talks about where services will be provided. Are you stating that all services must be rendered one site at one of the local career centers, if so would that be with availability during all applicable business hours?

A: As can be coordinated - Yes it will - and upon request & negotiation may be available on weekends for recruitment and intake. Activities beyond these should be away from the Career Central Centers

Q: Is it required to staff each of the Centers on a full time basis?

A: No
